## HOSTAS----2010

**Size:** After the name of each hosta, we have listed the size of the plant, based upon the approximate **diameter** of the plant at maturity. Although some hostas grow more upright than others, height will generally correspond to diameter (i.e., the larger the diameter, the taller the plant).

**Diameter** of mature plant:

[D] = Dwarf, up to 6"      [S] = Small, 8"-16"      [MS] = Medium-Small, 18"-24"      [M] = Medium, 26"-36"  
 [ML] = Medium-Large, 36"-40"      [L] = Large, 40"-48"      [XL] = Extra-Large, over 48"
