

Hostas 2012

Size: After the name of each hosta, we have listed the size of the plant, based upon the approximate **diameter** of the plant at maturity. Although some hostas grow more upright than others, height will generally correspond to diameter (i.e., the larger the diameter, the taller the plant).

Diameter of mature plant:

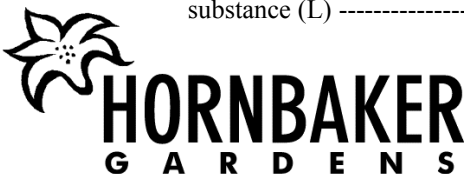
