ACHILLEA millefolium 'Sunny Seduction' (Yarrow) buttery yellow flowers bloom slightly earlier than others in summer; more compact and uniform than 'Moonshine'; 24-28 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	7.99
ACHILLEA millefolium Tutti Frutti 'Pomegranate' (Yarrow) magenta-red flowers throughout the summer; foliage has a uniform habit and strong stems; heat and drought tolerant; 25-29 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ACHILLEA 'Moonshine' (Yarrow) aromatic foliage with sulfur yellow flowers in early summer; sun; 18-24 inches; Zone 3-----	7.99
ACHILLEA 'Saucy Seduction' (Yarrow) uniform canopies of rose-pink flowers atop shorter and more compact foliage; 18-20 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	7.99
ACHILLEA 'Strawberry Seduction' (Yarrow) large, velvety red flowers with yellow centers form a uniform canopy; shorter and more compact habit; 18-20 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	7.99
ACHILLEA tomentosa 'Goldie' (Yarrow) large clusters of golden yellow flowers atop very short, compact stems throughout the summer; heat and drought tolerant; 6-8 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	7.99
AEGOPODIUM podagraria 'Variegatum' (Snow on the Mountain) rapid spreading ground cover with green and white leaves; white flowers from late May until late June; will grow in poor soil, sun or shade; Zone 3 -----	7.99
AGAPANTHUS 'Blue Yonder' (Lily of the Nile, African Lily) large clusters of blue flowers above rich green foliage in summer; clumping habit; 24-30 inches; full sun; Zone 5-----	14.99
AGASTACHE 'Blue Fortune' (Anise Hyssop) lavender blue bottlebrush-like flowers from mid summer to early fall; this long bloomer provides color late in the season; 24-36 inches; sun; Zone 4-----	7.99
* AGASTACHE 'Bolero' (Hyssop) darker bronze foliage and rose purple flowers with purple calyxes; blooms mid summer to early fall; aromatic foliage; 16 inches; full sun; Zone 5-----	7.99
AJUGA reptans 'Black Scallop' (Bugleweed) smaller-scale groundcover with glossy, near-black, scalloped leaves; stays compact; blue flowers; sun or shade; Zone 4 -----	7.99
AJUGA reptans 'Burgundy Glow' (Bugleweed) variegated foliage of burgundy, creamy white and green which gives a vivid tricolor effect; blue flowers on 6 inch spikes; sun or shade; Zone 3 -----	7.99
* AJUGA reptans 'Party Colors' (Bugleweed) tri-colored foliage of creamy-white, rose-burgundy and dark green; larger, scalloped leaves like 'Black Scallop'; violet blue flowers in spring; 3-6 inches; Zone 3-----	7.99
ALCEA 'Fiesta Time' (Hollyhock) relatively short spikes of double, cherry pink, fringed blossoms beginning in midsummer; 36 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ALCHEMILLA erythropoda (Dwarf Lady's Mantle) a diminutive form of Alchemilla mollis, only 6 inches tall; yellowish green, star-shaped flowers in June; sun to shade; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ALCHEMILLA mollis (Lady's Mantle) an easy to grow evergreen ground cover with rounded, lobed leaves; tiny yellowish green flowers in June stand 18 inches tall; sun to shade; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ALLIUM senescens 'Mongolian Gem' (Ornamental Onion) blue green strap-like leaves with 2 inch balls of lavender-pink flowers; sun; 18 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ALLIUM tanguticum 'Summer Beauty' (Nodding Onion) clusters of lavender-blue flowers bloom all summer; glossy dark green narrow foliage forms dense clumps; drought tolerant; 18-20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	7.99
* ALSTROEMERIA 'Inca Ice' (Peruvian Lily) soft apricot pink and creamy yellow flowers in summer atop an upright clump of linear green leaves; a great cut flower; 2-3 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 5 -----	14.99
AMSONIA 'Blue Ice' (Blue Star) clusters of periwinkle blue, star-shaped flowers from late spring to early summer; foliage turns yellow in fall; forms a compact clump; 12-16 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99

AMSONIA hubrichtii (Arkansas Blue Star) native with very narrow, needle-like leaves that line the stems like bottlebrushes; clusters of small, light blue, star-shaped flowers; golden fall color; sun to part shade; 3' tall; Zone 4 -----	7.99
ANEMONE hupehensis 'September Charm' (Japanese Anemone) rose pink, single flowers in late summer, 24-36 inches tall; sun to part shade; Zone 4 -----	7.99
ANEMONE 'Pamina' (Japanese Anemone) a good choice for late summer and autumn flowering; double pink flowers on 36-inch stems; part shade is best; Zone 5 -----	7.99
ANEMONE sylvestris (Snowdrops) pure white flowers in spring on 18-inch plant; vigorous spreader for partly shaded location; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ANEMONE x 'Whirlwind' (Windflower) pure white semi-double flowers in late summer, 36 inches tall; free flowering; sun to part shade; Zone 4 -----	7.99
* AQUILEGIA 'Blue Bird' (Columbine) light blue sepals with white petals; compact habit and large, showy upward-facing flowers in late spring; 20-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99
AQUILEGIA 'Bunting' (Columbine) large, upward facing, 3 inch blue and white flowers bloom late spring to early summer; 24-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99
AQUILEGIA 'Cardinal' (Columbine) from the Songbird Series; dramatic red sepals with white petals; sun to part shade; 28 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
AQUILEGIA 'Dorothy Rose' (Columbine) unique rose-pink blooms with several flowers set inside one another; sun to part shade; 24-30 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
AQUILEGIA 'Dove' (Columbine) from the Songbird Series; graceful pure white blossoms; compact; sun to part shade; 28 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
AQUILEGIA flabellata 'Blackcurrant Ice' (Fan Columbine) a dwarf species with blue-green foliage and bicolor creamy yellow and purple flowers from late spring to early summer; less prone to insect damage; 6-12 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99
* AQUILEGIA 'Goldfinch' (Columbine) light primrose yellow blooms in late spring; compact habit and large, showy upward-facing flowers; 20-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99
AQUILEGIA 'Sunshine' (Columbine) large, bright yellow double flowers; very floriferous and bright spring color; 24-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99
AQUILEGIA vulgaris 'Winky Blue & White' (Columbine) compact mounds of blue-green foliage; small upward-facing blue and white flowers; small blue spurs; great for containers; 12-18 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
AQUILEGIA vulgaris 'Winky Red & White' (Columbine) compact mounds of blue-green foliage; sturdy stems of small upward facing red and white flowers bloom late spring to early summer; full to partial sun; 12-18 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
* ARALIA cordata 'Sun King' (Golden Japanese Spikenard) brighten up the shade garden with this tropical looking beauty; large, bright gold leaves, tiny white flowers give way to purple-black berries in fall; foliage is greener in deep shade; 3 feet; partial shade; Zone 3 -----	14.99
ARMERIA maritima 'Alba' (Thrift, Sea Pink) pure white pompoms bloom in early summer; excellent compact plant for the sunny border; 8 inches; sun; Zone 4 -----	7.99
ARMERIA maritima 'Bloodstone' (Sea Pink) tufted evergreen leaves; long flowering dark rose-red flowers in mid to late spring; sun; 6-8 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ARTEMISIA schmidtiana 'Silver Mound' (Wormwood) compact mounded plant about 8-10 inches tall; the foliage is fernlike and silver-gray; sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ARUNCUS aethusifolius (Dwarf Goat's Beard) rather fine, ferny foliage forms a small clump; creamy white spikes in early summer; part to full shade; 12 inches tall; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ARUNCUS dioicus (Goat's Beard) ivory white feather plumes bloom in early summer; a valuable addition to the back of the shade border; likes moisture; 3-5 feet; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ARUNCUS 'Misty Lace' (Goat's Beard) large, creamy white, feathery plumes on dark red stems; tolerant of heat and humidity; part to full shade; 18-24 inches tall; Zone 3 -----	7.99
ASARUM europaeum (European Ginger) shiny round leaves make an attractive, low-growing clump; likes moist, but well-drained location in the shade; Zone 5 -----	9.99
ASCLEPIAS tuberosa (Butterfly Flower) a fine border plant producing brilliant orange flowers; milkweed-type pods are used in dried flower arrangements; breaks dormancy late; sun 2 feet; Zone 3 -----	9.99
ASCLEPIAS tuberosa 'Hello Yellow' (Butterfly Flowers) bright yellow flowers clusters; heat and drought tolerant; blooms all summer; full sun; 24 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99

ASTER 'Blue Autumn' (Aster) vivid violet blue, daisy-like flowers bloom late summer to mid fall; strong, upright, disease resistant plant; 20-24 inches; full sun; Zone 5 -----	9.99
ASTER dumosus 'Wood's Blue' (New York Aster) light blue flowers in late summer; compact, dark green foliage; very mildew and rust resistant; full sun; 12-15 inches; Zone 4-----	9.99
ASTER dumosus 'Wood's Pink' (New York Aster) dense clusters of semi-double, clear pink flowers from late summer to mid fall; dwarf, compact plant in mildew and rust resistant; 12-15 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTER dumosus 'Wood's Purple' (New York Aster) semi-double, purple flowers atop dwarf, compact plants that do not require staking; blooms late summer to mid fall; full sun; 12-16 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTER novae-angliae 'Purple Dome' (New England Aster) deep purple flowers on a dome-shaped, compact plant in the fall; heavy bloomer; mildew resistant; sun; 18 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTER novi-belgi 'Alert' (New York Aster) excellent shorter plant with deep crimson-red flowers in late summer; attracts butterflies; full sun; 12-15 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTILBE arendsii 'Bridal Veil' (False Spirea) an arendsii type; white plumes 28-30 inches tall; mid-season; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 4-----	9.99
ASTILBE arendsii 'Fanal' (False Spirea) an arendsii type; early red flowers, 20-24 inches tall; dark bronze foliage; mulch to hold moisture; part shade; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTILBE arendsii 'Rhythm & Blues' (False Spirea) early summer bloomer with bright raspberry-pink plumes and dark green foliage; full shade; 25 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTILBE 'Burgundy' (False Spirea) unusual deep burgundy red flowers, thick reddish stems and deep red buds give this astilbe long lasting color; glossy deep green foliage; 24 inches; partial shade; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTILBE chinensis 'Vision in Pink' (False Spirea) chinensis type; late blooming with thick, pink, upright plumes 18-24 inches tall; floriferous and robust; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTILBE chinensis 'Vision in Red' (False Spirea) red version of 'Visions'; a chinensis type; red plumes 18-24 inches tall; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTILBE chinensis 'Vision in White' (False Spirea) soft white flowers bloom from early to mid summer; excellent color and texture addition to the shady or woodland garden; partial sun to shade; 32 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTILBE chinensis 'Visions' (False Spirea) a chinensis type; raspberry purple plumes standing 12-15 inches tall; late season; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 4-----	9.99
ASTILBE 'Delft Lace' (False Spirea) reddish stems bear open panicles of delicate peach-pink flowers; deep blue-green waxy foliage with silver overlay; 24-36 inches; partial shade; Zone 4-----	9.99
ASTILBE japonica 'Montgomery' (False Spirea) a japonica type; dark red plumes standing 24 inches tall; mid- to late season; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 4-----	9.99
ASTILBE japonica 'Peach Blossom' (False Spirea) light salmon-pink airy blooms open early to midseason; likes moist soil and partial shade; 20 inches tall; plant 18 inches apart; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTILBE simplicifolia 'Key West' (False Spirea) attractive dark burgundy foliage with shimmering carmine-red flowers; short, compact and lots of buds; full shade; 16-20 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTILBE 'Yunique Carmine' (False Spirea) a new series of hybrids that are very compact yet very floriferous; carmine red plumes in early summer; 14-18 inches; partial shade; Zone 3-----	9.99
ASTRANTIA major 'Star of Beauty' (Masterwort) starry carmine rose flowers with bright white centers; long flowering; shade tolerant; 20-24 inches; Zone 4-----	7.99
BAPTISIA australis (False Indigo) upright, shrub-like plant 3-4 feet tall, with blue-green leaves and indigo-blue flowers in late spring, followed by black seed pods; sun to part shade; Zone 3-----	7.99
* BAPTISIA 'Blueberry Sundae' (False Indigo) vibrant, indigo blue flowers late spring to early summer; a compact, well-branched habit with deep blue-green foliage; decorative seed pods in fall; 3 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
* BAPTISIA 'Dutch Chocolate' (False Indigo) velvety chocolate purple flowers from late spring to early summer; compact, blue-green foliage; decorative seed pods in fall; 30-36 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
* BAPTISIA 'Lemon Meringue' (False Indigo) charcoal buds open to bright lemon yellow flowers from late spring to early summer; impressive vigor for a yellow Baptisia; vase-shaped blue-green foliage; 3 ft; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
BAPTISIA minor (Dwarf Blue Indigo) indigo blue flowers on what looks like a miniature version of Baptisia australis; attracts butterflies; sun to part shade; 15- 24 inches; Zone 4-----	7.99
BELAMCANDA chinensis (Blackberry Lily) showy, 2 inch star-shaped flowers vary from bright yellow-orange to near red, and are heavily spotted with red; blooms late summer; black seeds in fall; 24-36 inches; full sun; Zone 5 ---	7.99
BELAMCANDA chinensis 'Freckle Face' (Blackberry Lily) 2 inch showy orange flowers in late summer with heavy red speckling and shading; 24 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	7.99
BELAMCANDA flava 'Hello Yellow' (Blackberry Lily) clear yellow flowers on outstanding dwarf plant, 18 inches tall; seed heads resemble clusters of blackberries in late summer; sun; Zone 4-----	7.99

BERGENIA cordifolia 'Winter Glow' (Saxifraga) red flowers in mid-Spring above shiny foliage; regarded as an improved 'Rotblum'; interesting fall and winter foliage; part shade is best; 12-15 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
BOLTONIA latisquama 'Jim Crockett' (Flase Aster) a compact variety with violet-blue aster-like flowers in late summer; a native species that tolerates poorer soils; full to partial sun; 18-24 inches; Zone 4 -----	7.99
BRUNNERA 'King's Ransom' (Heartleaf Brunnera) silver and gold sport of 'Jack Frost'; creamy yellow margins lighten to creamy white by summer; blue forget-me-not like flowers; 10-12 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 3 -----	14.99
BRUNNERA macrophylla (Alkanet) large heart-shaped leaves with small, blue, forget-me-not flowers in spring; likes moisture and part to full shade; 12 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
BRUNNERA macrophylla 'Emerald Mist' (Heartleaf Brunnera) heavier silver bars connect to form a silver collar around the perimeter of the leaf; light silver-dusting over entire leaf; baby blue flowers; part shade; 12-15 inches; Zone 3 -----	14.99
BRUNNERA macrophylla 'Jack Frost' (Alkanet) frosty silver overlay with light green veination makes leaves resemble cracked porcelain; blue forget-me-not flowers in spring; shade; 12-15 inches; Zone 3-----	14.99
BRUNNERA macrophylla 'Looking Glass' (Heartleaf Brunnera) a selection from 'Jack Frost'; leaves become solid silver and cup downward; tiny blue flowers above foliage in spring; full to partial shade; 12-15 inches; Zone 3 -----	14.99
BRUNNERA macrophylla 'Variegata' (Alkanet) large green leaves boldly variegated with creamy-white color; needs shade and good moisture to prevent margins from scorching; blue flowers; 12 inches; Zone 3-----	14.99
BUDDLEIA 'Bicolor' (Butterfly Bush) gray-green foliage; fragrant, lavender and yellow flowers up to 10 inches long; sun; 6-8 feet; Zone 5 -----	9.99
BUDDLEIA 'Butterfly Heaven' (Butterfly Bush) very large, fragrant, lilac purple flowers up to 12 inches long; well-branched habit; silvery grey foliage ages to green; sun; 6 ft tall; Zone 5-----	9.99
BUDDLEIA davidii 'Attraction' (Butterfly Bush) deep purple flowers, turning nearly red as they open; mulch for winter; cut back in spring; sun; 6-8 feet; Zone 5-----	9.99
BUDDLEIA davidii 'Black Knight' (Butterfly Bush) dark purple flowers; attracts butterflies and hummingbirds; prune back each spring; sun; 4-6 feet; Zone 5 -----	9.99
BUDDLEIA davidii Lo and Behold 'Blue Chip' (Butterfly Bush) a miniature butterfly bush! Grows to no more than 2 feet high and wide and blooms from early summer into autumn: full sun; Zone 5 -----	14.99
BUDDLEIA davidii 'Royal Red' (Butterfly Bush) fragrant, rich, purple-red flowers on a plant 5-7 feet tall; attracts butterflies and hummingbirds; prune back each spring; Zone 5 -----	9.99
BUDDLEIA davidii 'White Ball' (Butterfly Bush) tight, compact growth and stunning silver foliage; white flowers on a plant only 2-3' tall; sun; Zone 5 -----	9.99
BUDDLEIA 'Miss Molly' (Butterfly Bush) Good golly! Outstanding dark Sangria-red color; full sun; 4'-5' tall; cut back in spring; Zone 5 -----	14.99
BUDDLEIA 'Petite Purple' (Butterfly Bush) lovely dwarf, only 2 feet tall; purple flowers attract butterflies; trim back in spring; mulch for winter; sun; Zone 5 -----	9.99
BUDDLEIA x 'Miss Ruby' (Butterfly Bush) unique, vivid, rich pink blooms; attracts butterflies and hummingbirds; cut back in spring; compact habit, growing 4'-5'; full sun; Zone 5 -----	14.99
CALLIRHOE involucrata (Wine Cups) low growing, trailing plant; bright 2-inch magenta flowers with white centers, blooming until frost; sun to part shade; drought tolerant; requires good drainage; 5-8 inches tall; Zone 4 -----	7.99
CAMPANULA carpatica 'Blue Clips' (Bellflower) large violet-blue, cup-shaped flowers that bloom from June through September; deadhead for continuous bloom; good edger or rock garden plant; sun; 8 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
CAMPANULA carpatica 'White Clips' (Carpathian Bellflower) white flowers on low-growing plant; blooms June-September; deadhead for continuous bloom; sun to part shade; 8 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
CAMPANULA garg. 'Dickson's Gold' (Bellflower) low growing toothed foliage is bright gold in spring, fading to a chartreuse green by June; makes a striking combo with blue blooming varieties; sun to partial shade; 4-6 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
CAMPANULA persicifolia 'La Belle' (Bellflower) upright stems bear small, double deep blue flowers with a silver gloss; blooms continuously from June through August; sun to part shade; 24 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
* CAMPANULA persicifolia 'Takion Blue' (Bellflower) a showy display of lavender blue, bell-shaped, upward and outward facing flowers in spring; compact habit; 16-20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	7.99
CAMPANULA poscharskyana 'Blue Waterfall' (Bellflower) vigorous low-growing habit with sprays of starry lavender-blue flowers all summer; good groundcover; sun; 8-10 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
CAREX caryophylla 'Beatlemania' (Sedge) twist and shout over this mophead of green and gold; low grower at 6 inches, but up to 24 inches wide; best in moist, rich soil in light shade; Zone 5 -----	14.99
CAREX elata 'Bowles Golden' (Gold Sedge) bright gold foliage with narrow green margins; spectacular with blue Hosta or gold edged Hosta; moisture loving; part shade; 2-3'; Zone 5-----	9.99

CAREX hachijoensis 'Evergold' (Variegated Sedge) pendulous creamy-yellow blades with green margins; semi-evergreen; best in light to full shade; 12 inches; Zone 5 -----	9.99
CAREX morrowii 'Ice Dance' (Variegated Sedge) compact tufts of 1/2 inch wide, dark green leaves with clear white borders; excellent low maintenance ground cover; moderate spread; 12 inches; Zone 5 -----	9.99
CARYOPTERIS 'PETIT BLEU' (Blue Mist Shrub) compact growth with glossy green foliage; intense, deep blue flowers; attracts butterflies; 24-30 inches tall; full sun; Zone 5 -----	14.99
* CARYOPTERIS x clandonensis 'Sapphire Surf' (Bluebeard) compact mound completely covered in dark blue flowers in summer; 2 feet tall; full sun; Zone 5 -----	14.99
CENTAUREA 'Gold Bullion' (Perennial Bachelor Button) deep blue flowers on upright stems; yellow foliage spreads rapidly; sun; 12-15 inches tall; Zone 3 -----	9.99
CENTAUREA montana 'Amethyst in Snow' (Perennial Bachelor Button, Cornflower) large buds burst to reveal pure white trumpet-shaped petals; royal purple centers; fast grower; 24 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
CENTAUREA montana 'Blue' (Perennial Bachelor Button, Cornflower) blue fringed blooms; attracts butterflies; favorite cut flower; sun; 24 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
CENTRANTHUS ruber 'Coccineus' (Jupiter's Beard) long-flowering, carmine-rose, domed heads in summer; attracts butterflies; sun to part shade; 2-3 feet; Zone 4 -----	7.99
CERASTIUM tomentosum 'Yo Yo' (Snow in Summer) ground cover that is highly valued for its woolly-gray foliage; good specimen for rock gardens or edging; white flowers in May and June; sun; 4-6 inches; Zone 3 -----	7.99
CERATOSTIGMA plumbaginoides (Plumbago, Leadwort) brilliant blue flowers from late summer to the first hard frost; bronzy-red foliage in fall; excellent groundcover for late season interest; 8-12 inches; best in partial shade; Zone 5 -----	7.99
CHELONE lyonii 'HOT LIPS' (Turtlehead) deep green foliage with bronze-green tinge; requires moisture; rose pink flowers in late summer; attracts butterflies; sun to part shade; up to 3 feet; Zone 3 -----	9.99
CHRYSANTHEMUM Mammoth 'Dark Bronze Daisy'--#2 (Hardy Garden Mum) bright bronze, daisy-shaped flowers from late summer until frost; requires no pinching, pruning, or deadheading; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
